# APPENDIX IV <br> RULES FOR THE ORGANIZATION AND FUNCTION OF THE ASSOCIATED MEMBER COMPANIES COMMITTEE (AMCC) 

(1) Article 3, point C (Associated Member Companies) of the ICG Constitution states: «Glass companies may be admitted as Associated Members of ICG and participate in all activities. They should pay annually to the Treasurer the subscription fixed by the Council of $I C G$ ».
The following items clarify the organization and function of the AMCC:
(2) Associated Member Companies (AMCs) are encouraged to organize a representative committee, i.e. the Associated Member Companies Committee (AMCC). It is the goal of the AMCC

- to be the voice of the international glass industry within ICG,
- to identify and propose topics to guide the work of Technical Committees (TCs), - to check the progress of realization of such work, and to propose further topics.
(3) As specified in $\S 4.1$, Article 7.1 of the Constitution, each AMC can send a number of delegates to the AMCC. The number of delegates depends on the subscription fee; see (9).
(4) The President and Vice President of ICG as well as the CTC Chair participate in the AMCC with the right to speak, however, without voting rights.
(5) The AMCC meets at least twice per year.
(6) The AMCC elects, from their midst, a President and a Vice President to be in charge for two years. The most voted and second most voted AMCC members become President and Vice President, respectively. Re-election is possible. However, President and Vice President must not be from the same company.
(7) The AMCC submits its proposals and its evaluations to the Steering Committee of ICG for approval. The final approval is given by the Council.
(8) The AMCC can send two delegates to the Council (in general the AMCC President and Vice President). They have the right to speak, but no right to vote.
(9) There are four categories of AMCC membership. The annual fees, number of delegates to the AMCC and number of slots of IM via belonging to an AMC are specified below:

*) speaking but no voting right in the AMCC; not eligible for president, vice president, or representation of the AMCC in the Council.
The number of delegates as mentioned in $\S 4.1$, Article 7.1 of the Constitution is adjusted accordingly.
(10) The status of Corporate Members (CM) is a historically grown category of ICG, however, since the Council ruling of Dec. 2021 no longer foreseen in the ICG Constitution. Present CM are automatically transferred to the status to AMC as stated in (9).
